Develop the Church Building:

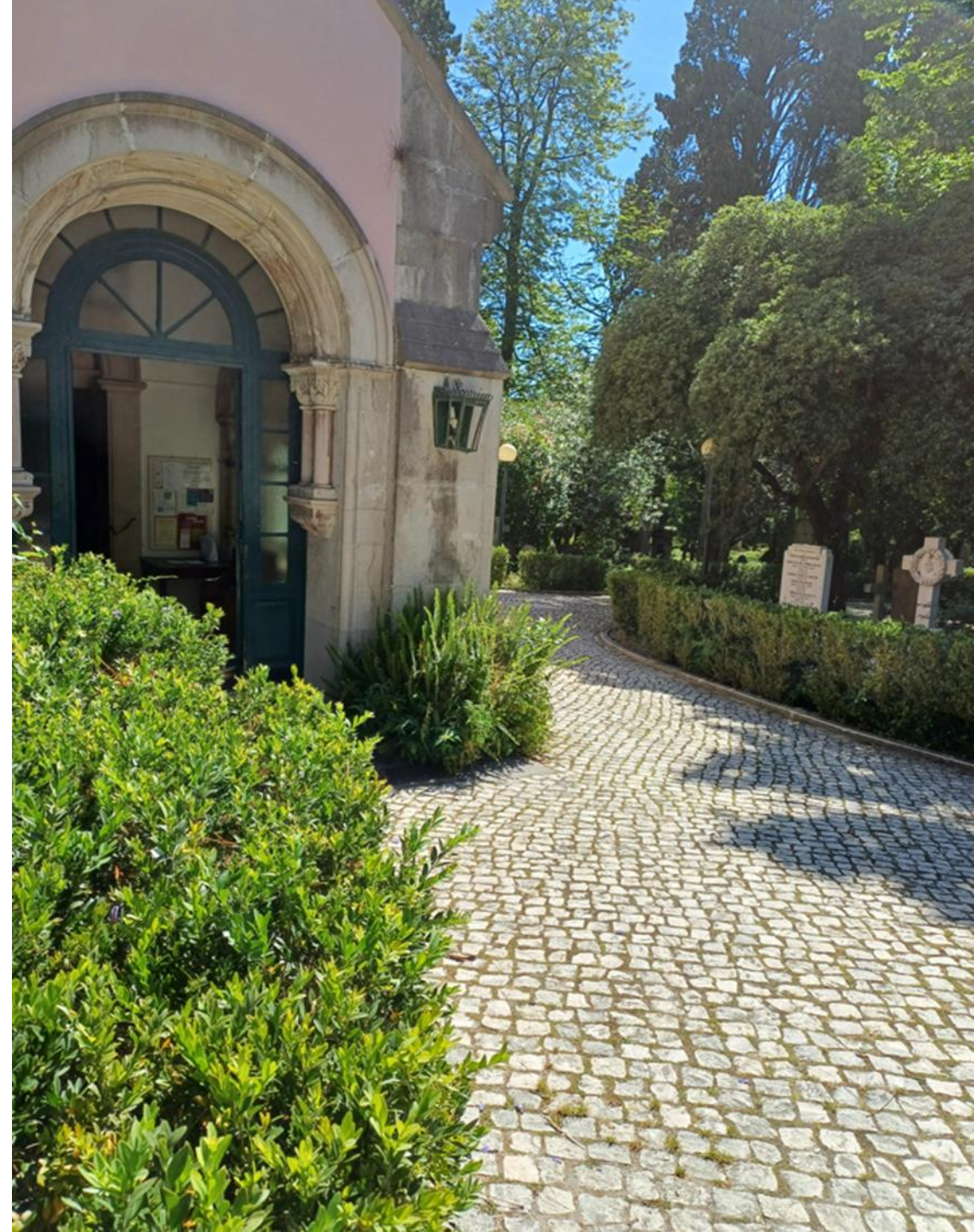
Our historical church will become a sanctuary of heritage and hope, open and welcoming to all. We recognise God's presence at the heart of this transformation.

These grounds will be a serene oasis for reflection and renewal. As we care for them, we honour God's creation and offer a place of solace.

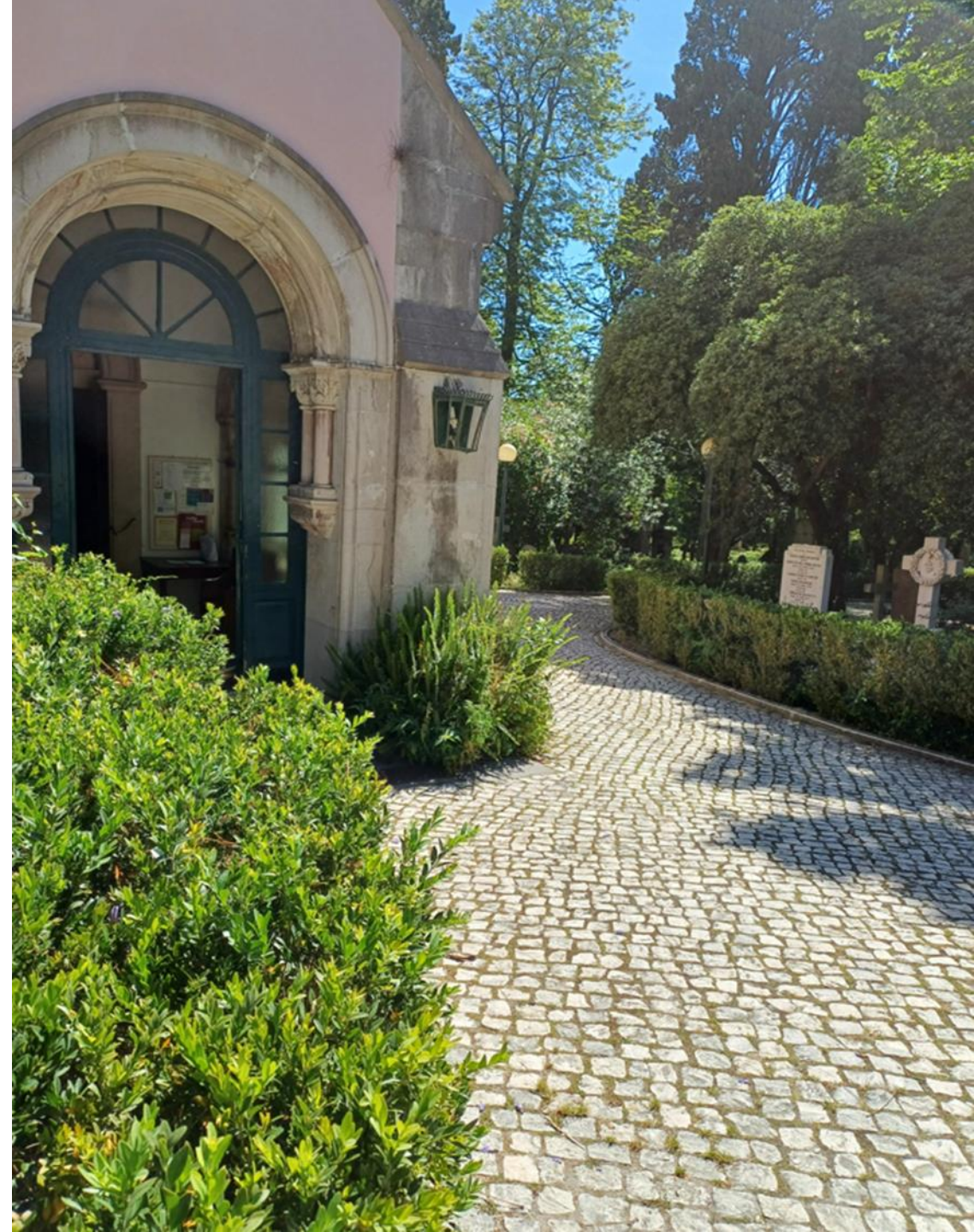
Mortuary Chapel Transformation:

5 Building Pillars of Action

1. **THE CHURCH, CEMETERY & MORTUARY CHAPEL** open 6 days per week. Self and guided tours.
2. **MARKETING and OUTREACH** to attract visitors and raise awareness. Web revamp. FB, Instagram. Engage with the Tourism Industry, the Local and International Community.
3. **DEVELOP EVENTS and PROGRAMMES** that engage visitors. Promote the church and grounds as a venue for events (concerts, art exhibitions, lectures). Partner with local schools for educational programs. Host community gatherings (picnics, seasonal celebrations, retreats)
4. **FINANCIAL SUSTAINABILITY**, generating revenue to support the project & the wider vision of the church. Encourage donations. Promote the flexibility of the church, cemetery grounds and hall, for weddings, private events, conferences and workspace.
5. **VOLUNTEERS**. Build & Secure a robust volunteer team with diverse skills to be available all year round and seasonal.

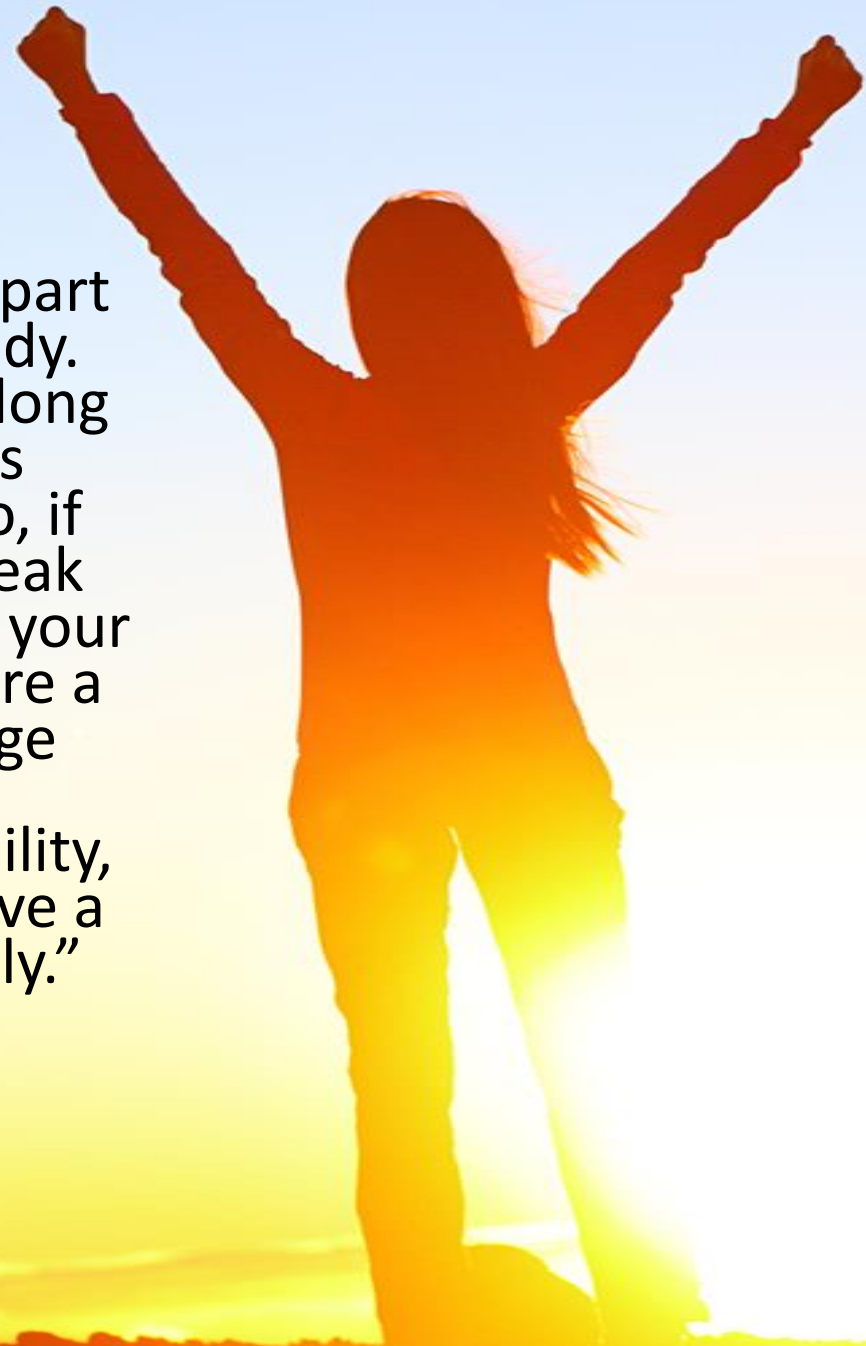
